#### Flood Insurance Update

The "make safe" works after the flood have been completed so now we are able to get quotes for repairs and reconstruction of the Multipurpose room, oval areas and garden including replacing sports and other equipment that was damaged. Unfortunately, this has been a long process with the contractors, insurance company and Covid-19, but we are finally seeing some light. We are getting quotes to have these works done and completed as soon as possible. We acknowledge the inconvenience for the students with reduced play areas and hope to restore them better than ever.

#### **Oval Update**

We have received a number of quotes to have the artificial grass next to the assembly area replaced and hope to have this completed before the start of next term. Replacing the grass on the oval is a major priority however the concern is that laying new turf, coming into winter we risk the grass not taking and wasting both money and time. With this we will need to rely on the advice from the experts.

The garden area will be replaced with a new look, that includes a usable outdoor learning space, garden beds, chicken coup and run, and the sand pit.

Planning for the new play equipment area near the river, is continuing and we hope to have a final design soon. We know this has taken far too long but unfortunately, due to Covid-19, all our plans were put on hold.

#### First Assembly



A special part of my working day over the last few weeks has been seeing and saying hello to parents/ grandparents as they pick up their children in the afternoons. I so look forward to being all together again as a school community. I know many of you will be very much looking forward to children's sport resuming in a couple of weeks. Since the restrictions began I have seen, on many occasions, parents and children out walking or riding bikes together and I hope these special family times will continue.

A few years ago our school held a Small Steps presentation for parents and teachers which proved to be very popular and informative. The program aims to raise awareness and improve the recognition of anxiety disorders in children. Topics include signs and symptoms of anxiety, the different types, referral and treatment options. Anxiety has increased significantly in our society and it is important to be able to recognise early in our children and seek help if necessary. The program is being offered as a free webinar.
