INFANTS PLAYGROUND UPDATE

While restoring our oval, we also received quotes to resurface the Infants playground with astroturf. After receiving expert advice, it became clear that restoring grass in this area would not be a sustainable long-term solution. I am working closely with Catholic Schools Broken Bay to gain their support to prioritise the resurfacing of the playground, alongside a complete refurbishment of the seating, which the whole community raised money for. This has meant a delay in the seating purchase with community funds raised as the astroturf would need to be laid first. Though, that would ensure we address the number of challenges at once in the current space, rather than just one at a time. Hopefully we will then be able to provide a more welcoming and practical area for the children.
